Reflections on the Samworth Academy event included:

- Good turnout from FTNCG volunteers
- Scope for improved communications (before and after the event) between FTNCG and other partners, e.g. Samworth Academy and the Forestry Commission

Action: Shlomo to write to Headmaster to thank the children for pulling balsam, etc.

Reflections on the Rainworth Walk included:

- Shlomo reported already receiving much positive feedback– the walk appears to have been enjoyed by all, with many saying how amazed they were by the size and potential of the site, which provides an archetypal example of Sherwood heathland landscape.
- Potential for some sort of 'route' linking Rainworth SSSI with Ransom Wood, Strawberry Hill, Oaktree Heath, Crown Farm, Spa Ponds, Clipstone Forest, Vicar's Pond, King's Clipstone, etc.

<u>Action</u>: Ian to prepare Group for work days planned for Saturdays 26th Oct. and 23rd Nov.

Rushpool update

Rich confirmed that Mansfield District Council (MDC) has made £4,100 of Section 106 money available to match fund for the heathland creation, interpretation and management project at the Rushpool site. Trevor (and Dilys) Pendleton will be carrying out a wildlife survey to provide baseline data (possibly by the end of August). See their website at: http://www.eakringbirds.com/ Community liaison events are planned for September 2013 and February 2014, along with numerous practical task days and some training days (see attached, but note that there could be some delays). The training is open to all potential volunteers, but would probably not appeal to our older members. The training may appeal more to Wild Sherwood, TCV and others. Rich was thanked for his ongoing efforts as FTNCG's Rushpool Liaison (with Sherwood Forest Trust).

Spa Ponds update

- Lorraine read out her draft letter, and all agreed that it should be typed up and sent to the landowner via the land agent
- Lorraine also read out the e-mail exchanges with Ben Charlton (a local 'sponsored fisherman') re: potential for a fishing club for Spa Ponds

- Archive visit to The Old Ragged School planned for later in August
- Barry and Alan's request for another pull seems too late for this now
- Clipstone Park Group was discussed The Group is intended to link nature conservation and heritage as well as the need to increase resilience in the face of transition (including climate change) within the landscape. Lorraine to arrange to meet with Mickie Bradley.

- Spa Ponds Appeal some progress has been made, but more needs to be done re:
 - o poster,
 - o press release,
 - o leaflet / factsheet (Andy Gaunt),
 - o internet stuff website and Facebook, etc. including adding new Spa Ponds section to FT.net website making case for why site is special (both heritage and nature conservation value), synergy with leaflet content
 - o Begging (sponsorship) letter, including brainstorming potential recipients
 - Thank and update those who have pledged (by September)
 - o Appeal to be promoted via Forest Town Village Markets, e.g. in September

Stinting Lane Hedge Surveying

lan is in the process of collating the data gathered in order to produce a list of species that have been identified (to make it easier to record any new sightings in Spring 2014). The evidence suggests that the hedges are at least 300 years old.
